

Support Persons on Labor and Delivery during the COVID19 (“Coronavirus”) Outbreak

Welcome to Labor and Delivery. You are encouraged to have up to two (2) support persons with you during labor and birth; for the safety of patients and their babies, we ask you to think carefully about who accompanies you.

It’s important that your support person(s):

- Feels well (no fever, cough, shortness of breath)
- Has not had any known exposure to COVID19 in the last 2 weeks.

Once your baby arrives, we are allowing your one support person to stay with you until discharge.

You may have one (1) visitor per day between 12pm-2pm or 5pm-7pm.

Thank you for helping us do all we can to keep our families and community safe.
