



## Support Persons on Maternity Units during the COVID19 (“Coronavirus”) Outbreak

Welcome! You may have up to 2 consistent support people with you during labor and birth.

It’s important that your support people:

- Have been feeling well for the last 2 weeks.
- Have self-isolated for the last 2 weeks.
- Cleans their hands often and does not touch their face.
- Stays with you in your hospital room as much as possible to decrease the risk of exposure to others.
- Following your delivery, you may have a support person stay with you until discharge. In addition, other visitors are permitted on the postpartum floor, one at a time during our visiting hours. Each visitor must be healthy and will be screened for symptoms of COVID.
- We ask you keep the number of support people and visitors to the minimum that you need.
- We encourage support people and visitors to limit trips outside of your room.
- We will provide meals for you and your support people.
